The following guidelines have been established by the teachers of the eighth grade's Blue Team in order to ensure a wonderful and successful year.

## 1. Be respectful and courteous

Being respectful and courteous is ultimately a matter of self-respect. Respect and courtesy are required of the student for the teacher, of the teacher for the student, and of the students for each other. Specifically, this includes, but is not limited to:

- A. Listening while the teacher or another student is talking to the class.
- B. Raising your hand if you have a question or an answer.
- C. Support each other with positive language in class discussion.

## 2. No Cell Phone Use, No Bookbags, Water Bottles Only Policy

Please remember that all cell phones must be off and in a locker from 8:15 until 2:50. If a parent needs to get in touch with you, they must call the main office. No bookbags can be carried. Children may only bring a plastic bottle of water with a lid to class, no other drinks or glass bottles will be allowed.

## 3. Be on time and ready to work as soon as the period begins.

You will have a consequence if you are late to class without a pass.

## 4. Come to class prepared with necessary supplies and assigned work.

Check your books during homeroom or after lunch to make sure you have what you need. Your iPad should be brought to class every day. Don't call home to have someone rush up work. Students in eighth grade are expected to develop systems at home to organize and remember work and items. If you forget work, bring it in the next school day. iPads should be charged overnight. You will not be allowed to charge it in any of your classrooms. If you are unable to use your iPad in class because it is not charged, you may lose points from your overall average. If your

iPad is broken you must see Mr. Vigliotti before/after school or during lunch to fix the issue.

### 5. Class work Expectations

All class work must be completed with care and effort. Complete sentences and paragraphs are always expected for written work. Students may only use the apps or web browsers that they are specifically instructed by their teacher to use during a specific class period. When using your iPad in class, Bluetooth must be turned on. If you are not instructed to use your iPad it should remain closed on your desk.

### 6. Homework

- A. All homework for each team class will be posted online.
- B. Students are expected to complete their own assignments on time.
- C. If you are absent, it is your duty to check with the teacher to see what needs to be done. It is not the teacher's responsibility to seek you out in order to collect what is due.
- D. If you've been absent, turn in your work at the start of the period on the day you return.

### 7. Extra Help

Teachers are available for extra help at specific times throughout the day. Students who desire extra help should make an appointment with their teachers. All appointments made must be honored. Obtain passes for extra help before the extra help appointment.
